

**PUBLIC SERVICE ADVISORY
ON CALIFORNIA WILDFIRES
30 July 2018**

The Philippine Consulate General informs the public of the following updates on Northern and Central California (NorCal) wildfires, gathered from various sources.

Carr Fire

- As of 30 July 2018, the Carr Fire in Shasta County has burned 98, 724 acres and is 20% contained. It has destroyed 966 structures, damaged 193 more, and forced the evacuation of 38,000 people;
- Evacuation orders have been lifted in the following areas: Eureka Way to Buenaventura Boulevard; Buenaventura Blvd from Hwy 299 (Eureka Way to Hwy 273); Teton Road, including the White Hawk Subdivision; Canyon Creek Drive, including the Country Heights Subdivision; all surface streets off of Westside Road, including El Reno Lane, Kenyon Drive, Branstetter Lane and Cedars Road; Branstetter Lane to Texas Spring Road, encompassing roads on Branstetter Lane; Hwy 273 at Westwood Drive, including The Westwood Subdivision; and Clear Creek Road from Hwy 273 to Honey Bee Road; and
- Starting today, from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. each day until needed, Bethel Church will serve as distribution hub for the Salvation Army at the church's campus at 933 College View Drive. Household supplies , such as baby food, diapers and wipes, personal hygiene items, and cleaning supplies, water and Gatorade, will be made available to those affected by the Carr Fire.

Mendocino Complex Fire

- As of 30 July 2018, the Ranch Fire has burned 35,076 acres and is 5% contained. The River Fire has burned 20,911 acres and is 5% contained. Together, the fires have burned 55, 987 acres, are threatening 10,200 structures and have destroyed 6 residences.
- The Mendocino Complex Fire consists of the Ranch Fire, about 8 miles northeast of Ukiah, and the River Fire, located 6 miles north of Hopland. Both fires started on July 27;

Whaleback Fire in Lassen Country- has burned 14,098 acres and is 20% contained. It is located northwest of Susanville and near the community of Spalding at Eagle Lake.

Natchez Fire (caused by lightning) and is located near the Oregon border- has burned 4,613 acres and is 10% contained.

Roxie Fire in Lassen County- has burned 167 acres and is 90% contained. Located 10 miles west of Susanville, the Fire has injured one person.

Crestline Fire in Shasta County- has burned 51 acres and is 97 % contained. All evacuation orders have been lifted.

Steele Fire in Napa County- has burned 135 acres and is 75% contained.
